Items in a Gnome craft kit

1 Decorative sock (cut in half at the heel)

1 ½ cup Gravel (dumped into toe end of sock)

Fluff

3 elastics

3 pins

Felt

Beard template

Yarn (30 wraps around first three fingers on hand)

1 straw

Instruction sheet to make Gnome

Gnome Craft Instructions




Pack your stuffing into the Gnome's body sock on top of the gravel. Fluff and shape as needed to get a good body base. Close the sock with one of the elastics.



Cut out the beard template. Trace template onto grey felt and then cut out beard.



Pin beard on to the Gnome's body up at the top by the elastic closure.



Once you have your perfect rock/nose wrap it in the square piece of fabric and tie an elastic around the back to hold the fabric on tight. Pin the fabric to the top of the body to attach the nose.



Turn your half sock inside out and elastic the end of it shut. Turn right side out again to make Gnome's hat.



You now need to make a pom pom for the top of your Gnome's hat.



Once the pom pom is finished, pin it to the top of your Gnome's hat.

Put your hat on top of your Gnome's body, make sure to pull it down far enough to cover the pins and top of the beard.

Your new Gnome friend is now complete!

Pom Pom instructions



Step 1: To make a pom pom borrow a parent's hand.

Cut off a piece of your yarn about 6 inches long and set aside. Wind the rest of the yarn around the hand. After, work the cut-off piece of yarn in between the middle fingers on both sides of the rest of the yarn.



Step 2: Tie the cut-off piece of yarn into a loose knot so you can work all of the string off the hand. Once it is off, tie as tight of a knot as you can in the cut-off piece of string. This piece should encircle the whole pom pom.

Cut the loops on both sides of the pom pom. Fluff and trim as needed.
